FROM THE DEAN

I have been reminded this week of the importance of friends, both being a friend and receiving friendship and how through friendship we often recognise the face of Christ.

The New Zealand writer Joy Cowley puts it like this in her book *Psalms Down-Under...*

Friend

Good on you, Friend, for being the presence of Christ to me. You came when I needed you.

You just turned up out of the blue, carrying no luggage, both hands free to carry mine, and somehow, you made it look as though I was doing you a favour by letting you be there.

But I do know that when I left you, the sun was shining, a bird was singing and there was a beautiful day waiting to be used.

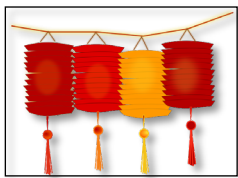
