Easter day

FROM THE DEAN

Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!

The Easter mystery of Christ's death and resurrection lies at the heart of the Church's liturgical life. In the spirit of the Risen Jesus, we are urged during the next fifty days to journey, as one liturgical prayer book puts it, 'on a high plateau.' The way is 'smooth and peaceful, full of joy in the certitude that the Lord is living.' It is a season of joyous thanksgiving.

After the ceremonies of Holy Week, it can sometimes seem like an anticlimax. But Easter should be proclaimed as a time for celebration and companionship on the Emmaus Road, an opportunity for dispelling doubt and bringing reassurance to all we meet along the way.

Henri Nouwen was realistic about this season of hope. He acknowledged that there can still be a painful awareness of sinfulness as well as fear but, there is also light breaking through. Something new is happening.

Something that goes beyond the changing moods of our life.

He writes in *With Open Hands* the following poem,

Hope needs to keep living amid desperation
and to keep humming in the darkness.

Hope is knowing that there is love, it is trust in tomorrow, it is falling asleep
and waking again when the sun rises.

In the midst of a gale at sea, it is to discover land.

In the eyes of another it is to see that you are understood...

As long as there is still hope

There is still prayer...

And you will be held in God's hand.
